Founded in 1973, AACI is the largest community-based organization serving the Asian American community in Santa Clara County. Most of our clients are low-income Asian immigrants and refugees. We utilize evidence-based practices in providing services. Current programs include mental health services for children, adolescents, families, adults and older adults, a center for survivors of torture, substance abuse prevention and treatment, programs and shelter for women and children who are domestic violence victims, CalWorks outreach, a senior center, primary care health services, HIV/AIDS prevention and education, after-school youth programs, English and citizenship classes, and advocacy.


