Foundation operates 3 alternative MH programs in city of Napa for adults. Programs provide three levels of community based residential treatment. Progress place provides crisis; Randolph House, sub acute (3 mos.); Laurel House long term (1yr.); residential treatment. All programs provide intensive milieu and Biopsychosocial treatment. These programs operate under contract with Napa County Mental Health and are certified and licensed by the appropriate departments of the State of California. Estimated commute from Berkeley is 50 minutes.
