Outreach and consultation services in the large catchments area include therapy done at local elementary school. The center is a multidisciplinary setting where trainees will have the opportunity to work with Adult Protective Social Services, Child Protective Services, Public Health, Drug and Alcohol Counselors, psychiatrists and a Spanish-speaking outreach team.
